

What are modern universities?

- Modern universities are longestablished centres of higher education in their communities with roots that stretch back decades, if not centuries.
 Many gained university title following legislation agreed by parliament in 1992.
- Modern universities are in every city and region, making up almost half of the entire UK university sector.
- Modern universities are a popular choice for students, with over a million students studying at modern universities every single year.
- Modern universities are groundbreaking, with over half (53%) of all their research assessed as world-leading or internationally excellent, and almost two thirds (61%) judged as having an outstanding or very considerable impact in terms of its reach and significance.

Improving health, education, culture and the built environment

Modern universities are at the forefront of health and social care training across the UK, educating almost two thirds (64%) of all students studying subjects allied to medicine as well as three quarters of all social work students.

Modern universities are influential centres of the creative arts and design, with **73%** studying these subjects at a modern university.

DCMS valued the UK's creative industries at **£92** billion in 2016, a sector growing at twice the rate of the overall economy.



In partnership with schools, modern universities educate our future teachers, with **62%** of all students studying Initial Teacher Training doing so at a modern university.



67% of architecture, building and planning students study at a modern university.
